Course Overview

In the UK, individuals must possess a National Water Hygiene Energy & Utility Skills Register (EUSR) registration before they are allowed to access or engage in activities on clean water sites or within the clean water network.

Delegates who successfully meet the requirements of the National Water Hygiene Scheme are granted the prestigious EUSR National Water Hygiene card, commonly referred to as the 'Blue Card'.

This scheme has been meticulously developed in collaboration with all UK water companies, and it plays a vital role in safeguarding public health and promoting good water hygiene practices.

The National Water Hygiene card grants holders the authorization to work in designated "Restricted Operations" areas, which encompass activities related to reservoirs, pumping stations, treatment works, wells, springs, boreholes, and work on the water mains network and service pipes.

Who is this course for

If you are entering clean water sites or working on the clean water network – known as 'Restricted Operations'

Course Content

This Scheme includes four modules, these being:

- The importance of water
- Water as a carrier of disease
- Potential contamination and its consequences
- Preventing contamination

Certification for this course maintains its validity for a duration of 3 years.

Assessment / Examinations

To successfully achieve this course delegates must pass an e-assessment at the end of the course and a basic command of English

Entry Requirements

A health screening questionnaire is an essential element of the scheme and must be completed by all individuals prior to the training and assessment

Once you have successfully completed your National Water Hygiene training and assessment, you will understand the vital part you play in maintaining clean and safe drinking water and protecting public health.

All new and renewal National Water Hygiene EUSR registrations are issued with a virtual card instead of the previous plastic card (also known as the 'Blue Card').
